San Bernardino County Sheriff's K-9 Bloodhound Captivates Rotary

The Rotary Club of Victorville was in for a treat this week; Deputy Ryan Girard, 12-yr. veteran of the Sheriff's Dept., introduced "Dare", the 3-yr. old Bloodhound belonging to the Rancho Cucamonga Sheriff's Department. The program is part of the Sheriff's K-9 unit, which includes two bloodhounds and two deputies, and assists law enforcement in locating missing children, adults, objects, and suspects who flee. Bloodhounds are one of the oldest breeds of dogs that hunt by scent and we are proud to have them in our county, and particularly in our own S. B. County.

There is no breed of dog alive who can compete with the bloodhound's sense of smell. In the event that a vulnerable person or suspect in a crime is missing, the work required by human peace officers is daunting and sometimes overwhelming. People can be difficult to find in our very urban environment and can deplete resources very quickly. A dog, on the other hand, has olfactory senses far beyond the senses of a human and can therefore locate a targeted scent very quickly. Dare can currently track any human scent over the course of several miles, even when the trail is several hours old and over hard terrain such as cement and asphalt. She proved her skills in tracking President Steve to his hiding place behind a tree on the Green Tree golf course this past Tuesday! It was quite thrilling to see her work, and to hear from her special handler about the program and the training that they are required to have.

Dare receives special feed supplements, is allowed little playtime, and has a physically demanding job. When her duty with the Sheriff's Dept.

is finished and she is retired, she will go to live with her handler, Ryan, with whom we could see a beautiful bond is formed. Thank you, S.B.C. Sheriff's Department for sharing Dare with Rotary!




