### **There's a New Sheriff in Town!**



The Rotary Club of Victorville was fortunate to have new Sheriff John McMahon as the special Guest Speaker this week, and he certainly came with both barrels

loaded and full of interesting facts about what he deals with as San Bernardino County's Sheriff.

The Board of Supervisors appointed Assistant Sheriff John McMahon to succeed Sheriff Rod Hoops upon his retirement in December, 2012. John has over 27 years of law enforcement experience, is married with two daughters, grew up and still lives in the High Desert.

John feels he works in a great department, and doesn't have huge changes in mind. Among his challenges will be management of a department that has seen budget cuts while its responsibilities have grown. The state's jail realignment program and jail overcrowding will continue to be a continuing problem, however there will be some relief with the expansion of the Adelanto Jail facility in late 2013. John states, though, that "We can't build ourselves out of this problem". "We have to look at things a little bit differently when it comes to rehabilitating these inmates." He explained the programs put in place that offer training for employment upon release.

In his spare time, McMahon enjoys fishing and horseback riding and serves as Chairman of the Sheriff's Rodeo Committee. We thank Sheriff John for taking the time to address the Rotary Club and share his perspectives.


