"Annual Bill O'Keeffe 'Service Above Self' Public Safety Awards" are presented each year by the Rotary Club of Victorville in the areas of Field Crisis Response, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, and Law Enforcement. This year's recipients exemplify the Rotary Motto, and are honored for going above and beyond the call of their duties. The late Bill O'Keeffe was a Victorville Rotary Club member since 1957, and retired in the mid-eighties as California Highway Patrol Victorville Commander. Bill was a 30+ year veteran of the C.H.P., and attained the rank of Lieutenant. Following his passing in 2007, the Rotary Club of Victorville named the annual "Service Above Self" awards in dedication to honor the memory of Bill O'Keeffe. In addition to the beautiful Rotary award, each recipient received Proclamations from the City of Victorville and the 1st District Supervisor Robert Lovingood's office. Mayor Pro-tem Jim Cox and Robert Lovingood's representative, Curtis Green, assisted M.C. Mark Taylor in the presentations.


Club Assembly
