Annual Bill O'Keeffe Memorial Public Service Awards

The Rotary Club of Victorville sponsors an annual Award in memory of Bill O'Keeffe, CHP Commander. Rotarian Mark Taylor, retired Victorville Police Chief, gave a brief history of Bill's outstanding tenure with the CHP and his Rotary service. In his honor, three recipients were presented this prestigious award.

Evelyn Greaver, American Red Cross, received the award for Field Crisis Response. Evelyn has demonstrated her commitment to the community and the Red Cross; she currently is Team Captain of the Disaster Action Team.

Deputy Sheriff Kristina Winegar is a Retail Theft Investigator for the Victorville Station, and is responsible for the recovery of large amounts of stolen property and exposing a multi-state theft/fraud ring.

Deputy Sheriff Kevin Riberich of the Victorville Police Dept. led the entire county in DUI arrests for July, 2011 through June of 2012. He is dedicated to removing impaired motorists from our streets.




IUCKY ORANGE MARBIE
