A VISIT FROM THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR

The Rotary Club of Victorville was honored this week by hosting a visit from the District 5300 Governor **Roger Gutierrez**. Roger took time to share his journey as a Rotarian and some exciting plans for 2023.

Roger joined his first Rotary Club in Irwindale CA, in 1984. He served as a member of the Board of Directors and ultimately Club President in 1989. Roger spearheaded a merge with the Rotary Club of Foothills Sunrise in Glendora CA in 1993. There, he was Club President in 2001-2002. After losing membership, he again orchestrated a merge in 2005 with the Rotary Club of Azusa CA.

Roger served as Assistant Governor from 2010 to 2013, then Executive Assistant Governor for five years. He has been District Membership Chair, Chief of Staff, RLI, P.E.T.S. Facilitator, Master SSA at District Conference and at P.E.T.S. Additionally, Roger has served on a FOCOMETER Project with his wife Sheila who, 20 years ago, started fitting eye glasses on children in Mexico, giving better reading ability to over 1600 children. He is passionate about the service Rotary provides to the local community and globally. Three times he has been named Rotarian of the Year.

A celebratory piece of news that Roger was proud to share is that four Clubs in the District are celebrating 100 years of service this year. Those Clubs are Monrovia, Upland, Ontario and Las Vegas New Club.
