## A Full Schedule for Rotary's Meeting This Week...

### **Tapestry Project**

The most recent incarnation of the Las Flores Ranch is a Master-planned community to include 9,365 acres in Southeast Hesperia. The Tapestry three-village development is planned in ten phases starting in the north and going to the southwest and south. It is generally located south of Ranchero Road, southeast of Summit Valley Road, west of Arrowhead Lake Road, and extends west along Highway 138.

The project includes 19,311 housing units, could take as many as 20 to 25 years to complete, and could ultimately add as many as 50,000 to 80,000 residents to Hesperia's population. The development will include homes, schools, parks, retail outlets and recreational trails.

Ginger Ontiveros introduced John Ohanian, Director of Development for the Terra Verde Group, LLC. As Ginger Hesperia City Hall

stated, "While the project is in Hesperia, it is certainly a development of such magnitude that it will impact the entire valley". Tapestry is actually the successor to a project approved by the City of Hesperia in 1990 on the Las Flores Ranch. Currently, the developer is working on the process of approval with several agencies. John stated that some of the unique characteristics of the development involve building a water treatment plant for not-potable uses, as well as the complete utilization of solar energy on the properties. John brought a Power Point presentation which offered a general overview of the project, and answered several questions from those in attendance.


