

GOLDSTONE DEEP SPACE COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK



The Goldstone Deep Space Communications Complex (GDSCC), commonly called the Goldstone Observatory, is located in California's Mojave Desert (near Barstow). Operated for the Jet Propulsion Laboratory, its main purpose is to track and communicate with spacecraft. They maintain antenna complexes in Spain, Australia, and the United States. These units track over two dozen spacecraft currently on missions to explore our solar system.

Carmen Cortinas, DSN (Deep Space Network) Security Services Manager for Goldstone presented Rotary with a fascinating look at space missions, newest spacecraft, and the new NASA vision. Goldstone is a 70-meter antenna, the largest of their projects. NASA's DSN operates three sites that monitor spacecraft

well beyond the moon, and over

two dozen spacecraft currently on missions to explore our solar system.

The Lewis Center Telescope Group's future scientists work with DSN to monitor and move two of antennae to gather information. The kids at the Lewis Center have

an amazing opportunity to work with DSN as it celebrates 50 years in existence. Margaret Cooker's husband, Tony, worked at Goldstone in its early years! Tours are conducted regularly. We thank Carmen for her presentation, and for more information, visit www.gdscc.nasa.gov.
