The Incredible Edible Egg

David Cisneros is a real life egg farmer, and proud that the eggs he produces can sustain life in America. David is General Manager of the West Division of MOARK, a subsidiary of Land O'Lakes. His Power Point presentation offered some fascinating facts about an item we take for granted in our daily lives. For instance, in 1940, one farmer could feed19 people, and today only 2% of the U.S. population feeds the other 98%! There have been significant changes and advancements in egg farming, driven by the need to feed our growing population. Some egg facts:

Eggs are an important contributor to the nutritional quality of the American diet. Eggs are high in protein and vitamins, but low in calories and carbohydrates. Eggs are a naturally nutrient-dense food, meaning they have a high proportion of nutrients to calories: one large egg has only 75 calories but provides 13 essential vitamins and minerals for about 15 cents each! Surprisingly, the hens never receive hormones, and there is no nutritional difference between brown and white eggs. In California, 200 million dozen eggs are sold each

year, and each egg is automatically washed and inspected. David explained the differences between cage free and free range hens, and answered questions from a very captive Rotary audience.
