The United Nations (UN) is an intergovernmental organization established on 24 October 1945 to promote international cooperation. Model United Nations (also Model UN or MUN) is a conference similar to the United Nations in which students participate as delegates to various UN Committees. Participants research and formulate political positions based on the actual policies of the countries they represent (Wikipedia, 2014). The students participate as delegates of the U.N. They research and discuss global issues intensively, while learning the skills of diplomacy and interacting with students from around the world. The NYC Conference brings over 4,000 students from over 53 countries! Our Rotary Club sponsors the MUN with a \$500 annual contribution, and judging by this year's presentation, this is money well spent in our community.

This year's team represents the Kingdom of Saudi, Arabia. Members discussed the dynamics of a Gulf Coast Cooperation (consisting of Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, and U.A.E.) with an informative Power Point program.
