Congressman Paul Cook Adresses the Rotary Club of Victorville



Congressman Paul Cook proudly serves California's 8th Congressional District, which includes the High Desert communities. Colonel Cook's military career spanned 26 years, and he earned two Purple Hearts and a Bronze Medal. Following his retirement, he began a successful political career, and distinguishes himself by attacking some of the most important issues of our time: government corruption, reducing taxes, and increasing penalties on sex offenders who prey on children.

Congressman Cook currently serves on three committees. On the House Armed Services Committee (includes two sub-committees), he is most concerned about the pending closure of the Barstow military base. In Foreign Affairs, terrorism and counter-terrorism threatens our nation and the world. Veterans Affairs Committee, he is a tireless advocate for veterans and military families, and in early March visited troops in Afghanistan. He has legislation being proposed to protect our troops at war and restore military tuition assistance.

The Congressman shared some of his views of what goes on in Washington. He compared the huge budget problems with playing Russian Roulette with a round in every chamber! Some good news, though... for the first time in four years, the Senate brought a budget proposal! The Keystone Pipeline, if passed, could bring many jobs, and free the U.S. from dependence on foreign oil.
