

# **Shear Realty Owner/Broker Explains the Current Housing Market**

So exactly which homes ARE selling in the Victor Valley? Caroll Yule presented a great Power Point along with her professional perspective as to the constant flux of the home real estate market over the past seven years. For example, in May of 2006, 90% of the number of homes on the market were REO's (bank owned properties). As of April of this year, only 25% of the homes are REO's; this is great news, and an indication that equities are rising in California. The market is turning, albeit very slowly. Caroll shared that 80% of the number of sales of homes are under \$200,000, affecting median home prices.


