Eddie Hernandez introduced guests this week. We welcomed Sergeant Rob McCoy and Detective Cameron Pratt, our speakers from the Victorville Police Department; Candi Albert, Marketing

Director for the Hilton Garden Inn (Castellucci); Jacquie Lukocsffi (Edson); and Breana (Sandra) Luna.

Detective Cameron Pratt of the Victorville P.D. Detective Bureau enlightened the Rotary Club of Victorville on tips for working together to operate crime-free business in our community. "Paper" crimes are on the rise, and business owners need to be diligent in order to increase the chances of success in prosecuting criminals.

DNA is a very complex issue and is time consuming to unravel. DNA stands for Deoxyribonucleic Acid which is a nucleic acid containing the genetic instructions used in the development and functioning of all known living organisms.

Det. Pratt showed surveillance footage from actual crimes in Victorville. It was obvious how the quality of the camera system is of utmost importance. Det. Pratt's advice on video surveillance camera placement: get an eye level view of face at entrance and where business is conducted; capture overalls of interior and exterior; capture license plates at entrance and exit of lot; have adequate lighting and audio capability. He also advised that the system be able to save footage for a long period of time. We thank Det. Pratt and Sgt. McCoy for a great presentation!




