The Arab Spring... Two years later



Dino Bozonelos, Ph.D., Asst. Professor, Dept of Social Sciences, VVC and Donovan Rinker-Morris, JD of Scimitar Globabal Management

Dr. Dino Bozonelos brought Attorney Donovan Rinker-Morris to update us on what has transpired in the middle east since Dino's last visit.

Donovan reported how protestors have galvanized since the 2011 incident which sparked the "Arab Spring". There have been upheavals in Tunisia, Egypt, Syria, Yemen, and Libya, which continue to this day. He explained the various reasons for the uprisings; from demonstrations, revolts and strikes to the toppling of governments.

The situation in each of these countries is volatile, to say the least, and there are many different players (with their own agendas) involved in this region. The U.S. Drone strikes in Libya, terrorist cells, social media, economic diversity... all play a role in the tension occurring throughout the area. The revolutions across these countries share some common thread and reflect divergent economic grievances and social dynamics, presenting difficult and complicated factors for resolution.
