

Team Leader Edgar Ibarra of the Rotary Club of Calama, introduced the four members of the team who each spoke a bit about their life in Chile. Edgar is a Clinical Psychologist and has been a Rotarian since 1995. He has held many posts in his home district, including Club President, Treasurer and Governor's Assistant.

Claudia Pizarro is a teacher of English Language in La Ligua, Chile and is sponsored by the La Ligua Rotary Club. She is a married, mother of two children and has been involved with the Rotary Youth Exchange in her hometown.

Fernando Velasquez (pictured left) is a Physician in the County of Punitaqui where he spends two to three days a week caring for patients at rural medical centers throughout the County. He
