No Room at the "Inn"

Earlier this month we heard one side of the AB109 and Prop 47 debate from San Bernardino County Deputy District Attorney, Kristianna M. Parde, and today we got the other side of the story from our speaker **Phyllis Morris**, the San Bernardino County Public Defender.

First of all we look at finance, for reducing sentences of "non-violent" offenders, the California prison population has been reduced from 8,000 inmates to 4,000, saving the State \$73 million.

More importantly we need to look at the social reasons for the adoption for this new culture driven change in our penal system. All sides agree that sentencing a criminal, having them serve their time and releasing them is not changing anything. Once you have a misdemeanor of any sort, it is extremely difficult to change your situation, so get a "white collar" career and more. This causes challenges on families where the parent or parents cannot get a decent job to support their families. As the cycle moves forward, it ends up the parents' children who turn to crime.

The passage of Prop 47 helps break the chain. 1 in 4 people in the prison have mental health issues that are never looked into. 4 out of 5 have substance abuse issues, that can, but are not being addressed through treatment programs while they are in custody. Prop 47 is to be used, not just as a "sentence reducer," but for Treatment and education.

In the Drug Courts, first time offenders can get involved in programs that will turn their life around, instead of a "treatment or jail" option. This will keep their records clean for their future as well as keeping the prison population down.

The Public Defender, Police and DA are all working together on this new "Holistic" approach, where instead of just conviction, they try to understand the individual: why do they commit crimes, what is the neighborhood like where they



live, what was their home life growing up, and what programs are already in their community to assist them. This proactive system will have a trickle down effect with first helping the parents, which will in turn stave off their children following in their footsteps.

Warehousing criminals is not working, so let's assist them. There is now no room at the "Inn", so instead of spending more money on prisons, let's help to change the lives of those who are willing.
