There are very few people in the High Desert who have not heard of **Cari Thomas** and **Jennifer Hernandez**. Cari, the former Mayor of Adelanto and Jennifer, the Executive Director of the Sunset Hills Children's Foundation have come together with others to form *"Don't Trash Our Desert"*. This group is a public awareness campaign to convey a coordinated and consistent message through a variety of means to encourage people to protect the appearance of our community by discouraging the dumping of trash and debris. The program is designed to augment existing efforts that address the issue of



illegal dumping of garbage and to inspire preventative action throughout the community.

The first phase of the program has just about been completed with the use of social media and electronic Billboards and working in collaboration with our local governments, the Victor Valley Transit Authority and media. The next phase includes working with schools, chambers of commerce, service clubs, churches and non-profit organizations.



Our own Rotary Club already has ties with Don't Trash Our Desert". **Ginger Ontiveros** is part of the committee, and donated 11x17 posters, that will go on all VVTA buses, thanks to **Kevin Kane**. **Doug Robertson** is having their logo out on reusable bags from the City of Victorville, and **Chris Ackerman**, our newsletter editor, created and donated their logo through his company, Signify Designs.

Now, how can Rotarians help this grass-roots effort? One way is to serve as a leader, and get behind the campaign, through donations, sharing their information, and support in general. 
