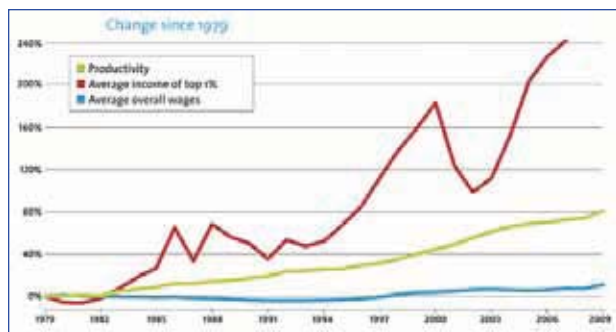

David J. Greiner is President of Greiner Buick GMC in Victorville. David presented a fascinating program this week to our Rotary Club, based upon “facts”... facts that he uses to forecast various markets (stock, real estate, etc.). He is a specialist in analytics, and stated that “there is more information that has been released since 2003 than in the entirety of mankind”! This incredible amount of information (some of it “Google Garbage”) is what is available for business owners to forecast their businesses. David shared his knowledge, and some of the statistics are pretty surprising. The chart below shows just how stagnated wages have been over the last 30 or so years.



The U.S. labor force is made up of only 63% of adults 16+ and over, and the global advances in technology have sent many U.S. jobs overseas. There is good news for our valley, as we have a very young demographic, spending 93% of their income, and purchasing homes. We appreciated David’s insights into the many facets of economics. His advice to business owners: In order to ascertain your client’s financial health, look at his/her debt load.

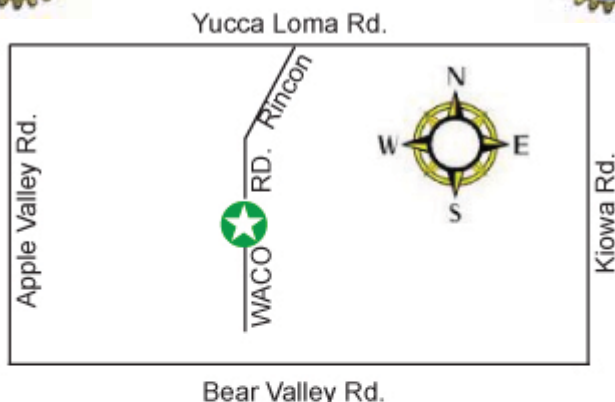

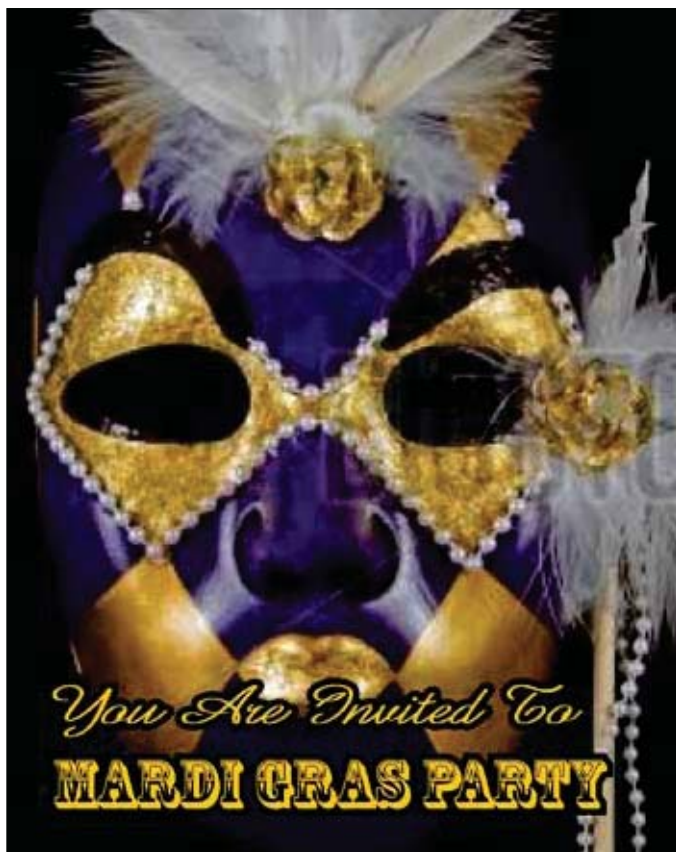
