## **Who Wants to Wear the Concrete Shoes?**



As a long time business owner in the High Desert, Jon Hove has seen it all. From early family beginnings, to building booms and depressions, his companies have survived, sometimes barely, and today, continue to thrive.

Jon's story begins in the early 1900's as his grandfather started in concrete work in Pasadena, California. To this day, you can sometimes come across "VC Hove" stamps in the concrete in that area.

Jon's father bought Hi-Grade Materials in 1955 as a way of staying in the family business, without having to pour concrete the rest of his life. The company started in Lucerne Valley and today resides on the corner of Bear Valley Road and Ridgecrest.

In 1990 the bottom dropped out of our economy and the building industry was hit very hard, but they survived with a lot of help. Most people don't realize the high costs of running a concrete company. Last year alone they spent between 3 - 4 million on trucks and equipment, not to mention wages and insurance.

The good news is our economy has bounced back and things are good. 400 homes are being built by Pulte in Jess Ranch, another 400 home project in Adelanto called Gateway, as well as many others all around the High Desert. In Commercial

work there is a \$3.5 million Dialysis Clinic going in on Hesperia Road as well as a Bakers Restaurant going up in Victorville. In Hesperia, a \$19 million concrete industrial building will be going up, as well as Family Dollar Stores in Boron, Helendale and Lucerne Valley. In Military and Government projects, there is the Hesperia & Apple Valley Water System, a \$57 million project as well as additional runways and taxiways at SCLA, in addition to bridges and more infrastructure.

Jon Hove foresees 2015 to end on a very strong note construction wise. As well as his industry, when construction does well, so does the rest of the community, such as realty, food and beverage and retail.
