

# **Rotary Club of Victorville Gets Educated About Biogas Energy**

According to Wikipedia: "Biogas typically refers to a mixture of gases produced by the breakdown of organic matter in the absence of oxygen. Biogas can be produced from regionally available raw materials such as recycled waste. It is a renewable energy source and in many cases exerts a very small carbon footprint."

The Rotary Club's speaker this week, Logan Olds, General Manager of the Victor Valley Wastewater Authority, had some interesting facts to share about Biogas. For instance, he compared the "digesters" to our human system, and how it relates to beans, broccoli, and greasy foods. The system will run off co-digestion of what Logan calls "energy packets" — also known as food waste and sludge. Logan describes the system as the most innovative sewage plant on the face of North America! Reusing and repurposing waste to create renewable energy sources can be an imposing challenge, and the hope is that the system can produce all the power it will require to operate.


