## Rotary Off-site at Scott Turbon Mixer, Inc., in Adelanto

WOW! Bill Scott must have way more than a passion for “things mechanical”... he has a building full of very high-end (made in America) machinery, and calls his operation a “glorified blacksmith shop”!



Bill started the business with his wife, Linda in 1980. After outgrowing four rented locations in the San Fernando valley, they decided to purchase property in the high desert, settling in Adelanto in 1995. Bill states, “Your business is only as good as your employees”, and he brought 25 families with him when he made the move, most of whom are still employees!



The primary industries who are Scott Turbon Mixer clients are Food, Pharmaceutical, and Cosmetic, and they “mix it up” for some of the largest manufacturers in the world, including: Pepsi-Cola / Kraft Foods / Coca-Cola / Marzetti’s Dressing / Ken’s Foods. Bill educated us on some fascinating aspects of the mixing business, which goes beyond just the mechanics of the equipment. Scott Turbon Mixer also develops the technologies to assist the manufacturer in improving its product, from the compounding of chemicals, air emulsifiers, to designing de-aerators. Try to imagine mixing up a 1,000 gallon batch of anything, and you’ve only touched on some of the abilities of Scott Turbon Mixers.
