Bill started the business with his wife, Linda in 1980. After outgrowing four rented locations in the San Fernando valley, they decided to purchase property in the high desert, settling in Adelanto in 1995. Bill states, "Your business is only as good as your employees", and he brought 25 families with him when he made the move, most of whom are still employees!



The primary industries who are Scott Turbon Mixer clients are Food, Pharmaceutical, and Cosmetic, and they "mix it up" for some of the largest manufacturers in the world, including: Pepsi-Cola / Kraft Foods / Coca-/ Cola / Marzetti's Dressing / Ken's Foods. 
