New Superintendent Updates Rotary on Victor Valley College

The brand new Superintendent / President of Victor Valley College is also a Rotarian from the Joshua Tree Club. Ginger Ontiveros of the VVC Foundation introduced Dr. Roger Wagner, who prefers to be called Roger (unless his mom is present), and gave a summary of his bio in the field of higher education.

Dr. Wagner comes to VVC from Copper Mountain College, where, during his tenure, he led the college through a period of unprecedented state budget cuts and successfully integrated the college's planning process that established a distinctive focus on resource allocation and student learning. According to Wagner "it was the dedicated faculty and staff that made our most recent accreditation visit the success it was."

His focus will be on accreditation and finance, which, he says, go hand in hand. He hopes the community will help spread the word that even while on probation, the college is accredited. The challenge will be finalizing the budget, which sometimes offers surprises from the state of California. He is interested in creating a culture of trust and transparency, dwelling on today and the future. Dr. Wagner's leadership philosophy is based on "Servant Leadership", and he feels the solutions lie in the talent, background, knowledge, and skills of his staff. Servant leadership is both a leadership philosophy and set of leadership practices which puts the needs of others first and helps people develop and perform as highly as possible.
