Building Blocks and the City's Budget

Victorville City Manager and Rotary Club member Doug Robertson demonstrated the reality of balancing the City's budget through his exercise with "building blocks".

Victorville Rotarians learned... this is not a simple task! Doug had presented this program to another group recently, and just happened to have the materials in his car, so stepped up to offer it to the Rotary Club of Victorville in their speaker's unplanned absence this week.

The following departments are within the City's budgetary responsibilities: Community/Public Services: Facilities / Library / Parks / Recreation Administration: City Manager / City Council / City Clerk / City Attorney Internal Services: Finance / Human Resources / Information Technology Police: Dispatch / Patrol / Administration/Leadership

Fire: Suppression / Prevention/Inspection / Dispatch / Administration/Leadership Development/Public Works: Planning / Building Inspection / Code Enforcement /

Business License / Street Maintenance / Street Sweeping

There have been many tough years recently, as "the budget goes the way the economy goes". About six years ago, the City of Victorville faced a deficit of about \$13.4 million dollars, and Doug described the severe cuts that were necessary and difficult to make at that time. The challenge for Rotarians was to "build" the budget for a city by allocating funds to each of the departments using a total of 50 blocks; each block representing a million dollars. A couple of scenarios were

approached which reflected the recent economic ups and downs faced by the Victorville City Council.

It was interesting that most teams reflected a similar consensus in the challenge of balancing expenditures and revenues while also estimating for an unknown economic future. This interactive lesson was a fun and enlightening exercise, and we thank Doug for bringing it to Rotary!
