Buckle Up for Barstow!

Changes are coming to both the Victorville and Barstow Courts according to Judge Raymond Haight, III and Judge Dwight Moore. Judge Haight, who in 2016 will become the Presiding Judge for the San Bernardino County Superior Court, shared that there have been a lot of changes/in the court system over the past 3 years. They have had to shrink the court system by 20% due to

budget cuts. The Barstow court was barely saved, and at the moment has only one judge there, presiding only 3 days a week. This year has been the first time in a long while that they have received a small amount of money, and will be making some necessary changes. The biggest impact to our area is now all traffic ticket citation issues and small claims proceedings will be only handled in Barstow. That

means if you get a traffic ticket in Victorville, you will have to take care of it in Barstow. As this will be a burden on some, there will be a drive up window in Barstow to handle these traffic tickets and for small claims and to dispute a ticket, you can do all of the preliminary work Online and only have to travel to Barstow once for the trial or hearing.

This move will create more space in the Victorville Courthouse to handle the more serious cases of felony crimes, misdemeanors and family court cases, which handle everything to child custody, to spousal support. As the local system stands right now, there are just too few judges to handle the case loads and this move will allow them to compartmentalize these three departments to handle more cases, settle more cases before going to trail, and helping families in desperate need in the court system throughout the High Desert.

The change is looking to take place on October 13 of this year, so there will be a lot of discussion within the community about this move coming up very quickly. Watch your speed everyone...it will now cost you a drive to Barstow.
