OUTGOING 1ST COUNTY SUPERVISOR BRAD MITZELFELT VISITS ROTARY



Brad Mitzelfelt took time from his duties as County Supervisor to visit the Rotary Club of Victorville one more time before stepping down from his post. He thanked the Rotary Club for its continued interest in his position as Supervisor of our district.

Brad is raising his family in San Bernardino County, and says he is invested here. He looks forward to continuing the work to make our communities better.

Considering the economic times and budget cuts, there are many challenges in the economic development of the county. In addressing those issues, "there will be short term discomfort", stated Brad, and added, "We've cut our discretionary spending in the last four years at the county by almost 50 percent. That's huge!" Specifically,

Brad reported on our County Museum in Apple Valley, Calico Ghost Town improvements, Mojave Narrows project, and the San Bernardino County Fair, the only fair on Route 66.

Brad hopes his successors "have a love and a passion for the desert and what makes it special, and that they work to preserve those things". He values our county's cultural assets... regional parks, libraries, and museums, and plans to focus on those items in the future as a private citizen. He is proud of the work that's been done on the Nisqually Interchange, Ranchero, and Yucca Loma Bridge; the big ticket items, and states that solar and mining also present opportunities. Thank you, Brad, for sharing your observations, and we look forward to seeing you at more meetings of the Rotary Club of Victorville!




