MACERICH REPORTS ON MALL OF VICTOR VALLEY ENHANCEMENTS



The Mall of Victor Valley Manager, Vito Bello, introduced Liz Hewson, Property Manager of the Macerich Company, to share with us the exciting events occurring at the Mall. Macerich Co. owns and operates over 100 regional shopping malls in the western US.

Since it was built in 1986, the Mall of Victor Valley has offered a variety of employment opportunities, and despite losing two major anchor stores (Mervyn's and Gotschalks), the Mall is growing and thriving. J.C. Penney's is expanding and relocating into the old Mervyn's store. The opening will be October 5th, and they are doubling their size. Macy's Department Store will be opening in the former Gotschalks location, and it is also about 100,000 square feet. Their opening is set for March, 2013. Both J.C. Penney's and Macy's are "prototype" stores; the only other similar Macy's store is in Times Square!


WELCOME...


