VICTOR VALLEY WASTEWATER RECLAMATION AUTHORITY PROJEC

The VVWRAGeneral Manager, Logan Olds, explained to the Rotary Club of Victorville how a storm disaster in 2010 initiated a current huge project in the north end of Mojave Narrows. Excessive rain water flowing through the Mojave River caused sand and debris to infiltrate the system in the Upper Narrows area causing a blockage. As a result, a mixture of river water and wastewater was released below the surface of the Mojave River.

In the eight days following the discovery of the damaged pipe, VVWRA built a temporary emergency bypass to circumvent the damaged section of pipeline. It took roughly 5,000 feet of pipe and the construction of a pipe bridge to complete the project. According to Logan, it was a major feat for the bureaucracies of the Army Corp. of Engineers, Fish & Game, combined with the California Environmental Quality Act/National Environmental Protection Act, etc. to grant the VVWRA approval to begin cleaning up the mess so hastily (generally a five-year permitting process).

The VVWRA Board of Commissioners has approved a plan to repair the damaged pipeline by taking it out of the river and tunneling



through the Upper Narrows. The scope of this project is practically immeasurable, and will be an ongoing project for the next nine months (approximately). It is scheduled for completion by mid- 2014, and

will affect those traveling through the downtown Victorville area of D Street and the Narrows in early spring of next year. Get ready, folks, for some major roadway diversions and traffic congestion in an area already overwhelmed traffic-wise.


