HOW HEALTH CARE REFORM IMPACTS THE PRESIDENTIAL RACE



Dr. Margaret Peterson, Rotarian, and CEO of Desert Valley Hospital, shed some light on the various aspects of President Obama's Health Care plan. She offered a great Power Point presentation which also delineated Governor Romney's own proposals to repeal and replace it with a different set of reforms. In addition to a history of American health care, Margaret shared a great handout from the UCLA Center for Health Policy Research, with a side-by-side comparison of the candidates' health care proposals.

The cost of health care was the catalyst long before the reforms began in 2010. As Margaret states, "Because we live in a capitalist environment, profits are built into health care, whether it's for profit hospitals, health insurance companies, pharmaceutical companies, durable medical goods... profit is how we function".

Margaret compared how Americans are insured against nationalized health care systems in other countries. She also explained some of the issues regarding Medicare and Medicaid.

We all know there is a huge need for reform, and a long list of "fixes" from both sides. Just "Google" Health Reform, and see the many groups that offer their own answers to how the reform will play out in the future, and how it will affect you and your employees.

We thank Margaret for her informative presentation, and also for providing a concise summary of the ballot measure questions as presented by the Victorville Chamber and CalChamber.

IMPORTANT ISSUES:

- Cost of Health Care Rising 18% of Gross Domestic Product (\$2.6 Trillion) - Highest in the World - however, US ranks 50th in the world in life expectancy
- 50 million people are uninsured 1 in 6 Americans
- Three pandemics contribute to preventable chronic diseases - tobacco use, obesity & lack of physical activity
- Capitalism in Health Care health care driven by profit


