Firefighters Make a Difference

Ginger Ontiveros introduced "one of the heroes of the college", Fire Chief Tom Turner. Some Victorville Rotarians who had youthful dreams of becoming a Firefighter got a glimpse of what it takes to be "hot stuff", sporting the flourescent-striped suits!

Chief Turner began his fire fighting career in Victorville in 1981 and retired as a captain in 1984. He has been teaching Fire Technology at VVC for about 15 years. We appreciated Tom being at the ready to speak to us on short notice, and it was fun to see our fellow Rotarians dressing the part of a Fireman! A Firefighter is required to wear very heavy safety gear (from 60-80 lbs.). As demonstrated by our own Rotarians, it's not easy to put it on quickly! Aside from the uniform, there are hoses, bottles, and various other equipment to be added to the extra weight. Obvi-

ously, a Firefighter must be in very good physical condition.

In addition to fitness, Firefighters are also required to be ethical and honest, and have a desire to be involved in the community. There are many ways fire districts help in their communities; from feeding seniors, mentoring youth, collecting money for injured firemen, etc. There is no "spare time" as a Firefighter. They work on maintaining and repairing the fire trucks and equipment, as well as cooking all their meals, completing reports, etc. Fire fighting is a great career, and the Fire Technology program teaches our young would-be Firefighters to be safe during their tenure. 
