MINI GRANTS FOR THE MIND AND THE HEART



This was our big one. This week our Club held it's biggest meeting of the year, the annual Teacher Mini-Grant Program. After canceling last year's event due to the pandemic, in 2021 we had 39 grants to give away to area teachers in the total amount of \$10,768.39! The event was hosted by **Alicia Anderson** and grants given out covered the Adelanto Elementary School District, Helendale School District, Excelsior Charter Schools, the Victor Elementary School District and the Victor Valley Union High School District.

The overall theme for many teachers including Excelsior, Helendale Elementary and Lakeview Leadership Academy dealt with emotional stress coming out of the pandemic with such programs as "Comfy

Math was highlighted by **Jared Nichols** at Cobalt Institute with "Pi Day, The Return" which will celebrate math on March 14th.

Dance and Exercise were also a big factor with "Lion Dance" from instructor **Jonathan McDonald** at Mesa Linda Middle School, "Jumping All The Way" from **Maribel Duenas**, and "Run for Your Life" by **Lizette McDonnell** at Lomitas Institute of Technology, where students will run 100 miles this year, with prizes when they reach certain markers throughout the year.
