TWO GREAT PROGRAMS FEATURED AT ROTARY



The Rotary Club of Victorville recognized two members of our community with the presentation of the "Community Service Paul Harris Awards". This award was created in memory of Paul Harris who established the Rotary Club over 106 years ago, and it is the highest award presented by the Club. Its' purpose is to acknowledge the outstanding contribution and exceptional service of members of the community by representing Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self".Rotarian Holly Noel assisted District Governor Miles Petroff and President Russ Stringham in presenting the honors. Tracy Walters works for the Mojave Desert Air Qual-

ity Management District, and in her spare time volunteers her time and talents in many needed areas in the community. In addi-

tion, she is an active member of GreySave, a non-profit organization which saves Greyhounds, and is a constant platelet and blood donor, donating a total of almost 11 gallons!

Ron Wilson (non-Rotarian) is the Director of the Victor Valley Rescue Mission, which provides services to the homeless of our community. A Thanksgiving and Christmas dinner is served at the Mission. With the support of our community, they offer: Refuge – Food, shelter, and clothing for those in need / Recovery – Biblically based programs to minister to the whole person; body, mind, and spirit and / Restoration – Equipping people to lead productive and independent lives.



Rotarian Ron Wilson Reports on Internal Banking Fraud



Ron Wilson shared interesting (and some funny) stories about fraudulent bank employees who took huge risks by stealing money and ultimately lost their ability to work within the banking industry. The first was a teller, who took \$200 in quarters; another teller "borrowed" \$200 for her Las Vegas weekend and tried to return it on Monday; and one who embezzled \$80,000 worth of withdrawals! A Senior Credit Officer was caught cashing cashier's checks, and was eventually caught by the regulators. He is banned from banking for life. A loan officer, making loans to herself, was caught red-handed due to a mistake she made in the loan papers. She was also banned for life. An employee in the payroll department advanced her own payroll until she was caught in an audit. The most blatant theft was a Chief Financial Officer who stole over \$600,000 over a period of seven years, and was never caught, in spite of federal and state regulators' attempts to find the missing money. 
