Rotary's District 5300 District Governor, Sylvia Whitlock, was assisted by Greg Lundeen in the presentation of this honor to both recipients. Mr. Lundeen, Deputy Superintendent, presided for Rotarian and Oro Grande School District Superintendent, Joe Andreasen, who was absent.

Chico Garza has worked for over 30 years with schools and businesses throughout the state of California. He retired from the U.S. Army after 23 years of service. Mr. Garza uses his lifetime experiences and real-life education to mentor others,

particularly youth and their families. He has made a huge impact promoting solid family values in the community.

Carl Ackermann's contribution to youth spans his 24 years as an Oro Grande School District Board of Trustee, Past Board Presi-

dent, and Basketball Coach. Mr. Ackermann retired as a Lieutenant Colonel following a 34-year U.S. Air Force career, where he served as Scoutmaster here and abroad. 
