Following Wagon Trails through High Desert History

Sid Hultquist, Apple Valley Fire Chief, has a passion for the history of our area, and considers himself an amateur Historian. Our Rotary Club totally enjoyed his presentation, which included history dating back to the 1800's The first wagon train came into our valley in 1848, just prior to the California Gold Rush.

Many tools are at Sid's disposal, the best of which is today's technology... the internet, satellite imagery, and G.P.S. (global positioning system). However, he admits to a lot of walking through the desert, and explained how he still finds remnants of what used to be the old wagon trails, in spite of



the tremendous development of our Victor Valley. He has visited libraries and museums since he was young, always looking for historical information, and credits VVC as one of the best libraries around.

Sid focused on the Salt Lake Trail (the very first trail into the valley), citing the importance of the historical aspects of the Mojave River Corridor. The Mojave Indians first began using the Salt Lake Trail in trading with coastal Indians. The use of this trail led to the development in 1829 of the first actual trade route from Santa Fe, New Mexico to Los Angeles, developed as a mule trail. In 1849, the first wagon trains headed west from Utah in search of gold on the Salt Lake Trail. Sid told us of the many difficulties travellers endured while blazing these trails, to the point of actually dismantling the wagons at one location in the Cajon Pass, and then re-assembling them after carrying the parts through the steep canyons and rutted roads! This was a most interesting program, and we hope to hear more from Sid in the future!


