Local Teachers Receive Rotary "Mini-Grants"







"Mini-Grants" of up to \$300 were handed out at this week's Rotary Club of Victorville meeting to 43 deserving area teachers from seven school districts. This totaled almost \$13,000 donated by Rotarians. Rotary's annual "Mini-Grant" program supports the most creative and innovative approaches to enhancing student learning. Alicia Anderson officiated, and asked a few teachers to explain the project that won their award. Some examples: 12 Woodshop Rocking Horses for "Santa's Workshop" / "Wiki-Literature, an on-line book discussion for students / "WiFi Netbooks" for classroom learning / "Put it There" to teach kindergartners organizational skills / and "Literacy Live", a reading program for preschoolers using books donated by the Rotary Club of Victorville.

Districts represented were: Adelanto Elementary School District, Excelsior Charter Schools, Oro Grande School District, Helendale School District, Victor Elementary School District, Victor Valley Christian School, and Victor Valley Union High School District.
