look into how this organization is making such a difference for so many kids.

Lift Up America coordinates events for at-risk kids and focuses on making the event a memorable day that they will remember forever. It starts with a "red carpet" welcome and it just gets better. The event may be a movie premiere, a celebrity meet and greet, a professional football game, or something else just as fun. Lift Up America has partnered with companies such as Tyson Foods and Lenscrafters which has allowed these kids to take home food as well as provide eyeglasses or hearing aids that were needed.

At these events, the kids are encouraged to take part in the "Ambassador of Compassion" training program to learn how to go back to their communities and make a difference. The program's goal is "... to help break the cycle of poverty, hopelessness and defeat in the lives of
